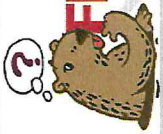

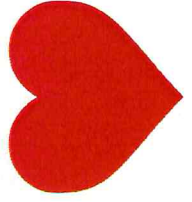

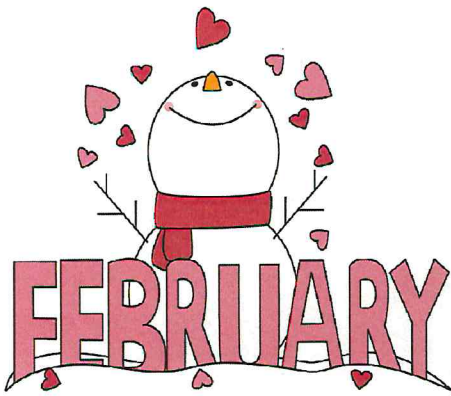

Cold and Flu season is once again upon

US:

Here are some helpful hints to keep everyone healthy and keep illnesses at bay. Please encourage your child to follow these basic practices that we do at school:

Please help your child to learn and practice how to cover his/ her - mouth when coughing or sneezing.

Sneeze or cough into your elbow. Encourage them to wash their hands before and after meals and after blowing their noses.

1. The best method for hand washing is with soap and water, if water is not readily available hand sanitizers is an alternative with adult supervision.

If your child becomes ill with a fever he/she needs to be fever free (without fever reducing meds.) 24 hrs. before returning to school. Even if your child appears to bounce back more quickly than that, it is important to give his/her body time to strengthen.

Reminders:

***School begins promptly at 8:30a.m. Dismissals are at 11:30a.m. and 2:30p.m. School closes without delay at 5:30p.m.**

***Morning children and extended day children should not arrive prior to 8:20 a.m.** Arriving after 8:30 during group time disrupts the group. Please call if your child will be late or absent.

* You may want to check the temperature readings before leaving your homes in the morning and dress your child accordingly.

* **Outerwear: Label your child's coats and sweaters with their name for easy identification. Thank you.**

- **Registration packets are currently available for the "2018" Fall semester.**

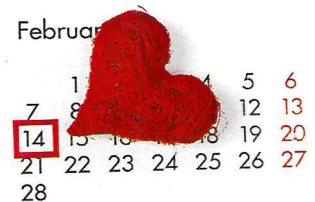
