### UPDATE on Mask ruling and COVID

The BPS School Board voted to extend the emergency mask mandate to October 29th. They also changed language in the emergency mask mandate to allow people to remove masks while indoors if they are socially distanced by at least **six feet**.

The Florida Department of Health issued an emergency rule that gives parents more power to decide whether children go to school after being exposed to people who have COVID-19. The new rule says schools “shall allow parents or legal guardians the authority to choose how their child receives education after having direct contact with an individual that is positive for COVID-19... so long as the student remains asymptomatic.” Parents also have the option of quarantining their students for up to seven days. The updated FLDOH flow chart on contacts to cases is attached with this email.

With this ruling we ask every student and staff member to be vigilant with hand washing, wearing masks that fit, and staying home if ill. We are running out of children’s sized masks. Please consider donating some to your child’s classroom. Students will be reminded as they get out of the car to have a clean, well fitted mask. This is becoming a burden of the teachers to keep up with supplying and reminding children about wearing a mask. Let’s help them out for the month by following the ruling, decreasing the spread of ANY germs, and letting teachers focus on teaching and not finding masks for students.
